- 🔥 Hose, Nozzles, and Ladders
- 🔥 Emergency Lighting
- 🔥 Portable Tank
- 🔥 Generator
- 🔥 Ventilation Fans and Saws
- 🔥 Flashlights
- 🔥 Small Engine (Pump)
- 🔥 Fire Pump
- 🔥 Communication equipment
- 🔥 Automated External Defibrillators
