Residential Firework Discharge Regulations

- Regardless of a permit, no person may discharge a firework with a burn ban in effect.
- An adult person 18 years of age or older may obtain a permit from the City of League City Fire Marshal's Office to discharge consumer grade (1.4G) fireworks only from sundown on July 4th – 1am on July 5th and from sundown on December 31st – 1am on January 1st.
- All Residential Firework Permits expire on January 1st of the respective year and shall be renewed annually.
- There shall be no structure, vehicles, or person within a 25-foot diameter of the discharge location.
- Fireworks must be discharged on a non-combustible surface of sufficient size to contain the entire portion of the ground display.
- Only consumer grade 1.4G fireworks shall be permitted.
- No more than 25 people can be at the location listed on the permit at the time the fireworks are discharged unless approved by the City of League City Fire Marshal's Office
- Permit holder shall be responsible for cleaning and removing all firework debris.
- The permit holder is responsible for any damage or injury to other persons or property resulting from firework use.
- Permit holder shall comply with all Texas Department of Insurance Requirements
- The permit holder shall not be under the influence of an intoxicating substance.
- Permit holder shall have an extinguishment device (ex. minimum of 5-gallon bucket of water, minimum of 5lb ABC fire extinguisher, and/or an operational water hose) readily available at the site of firework discharge
- Discharged fireworks shall be soaked in a bucket of water for several hours, prior to disposing of the debris in a trash can. A 5-gallon bucket will be provided with each permit application.

- Fireworks shall not be discharged from on or within a motor vehicle, watercraft, or trailer.
- Fireworks are not permitted to be discharged within:
 - o Multi-family residential complexes (ex. Apartment complexes)
 - o 600 feet of any church, hospital other than a veterinary hospital, an asylum, a licensed child care center, or a public or private primary or secondary school or institution of higher education unless person received authorization in writing from that organization. Written authorization shall be submitted at the time of permit application submission.
 - o Within 100 feet of a place where flammable liquids or flammable compressed gasses are stored or dispensed
 - o Within 100 feet of a place where fireworks are stored or sold
- Any violation of these regulations may result in fines, confiscation of permit, and/or confiscation of fireworks.

I hereby certify that the above information is true and correct. I have read and understand all of the regulations that go along with this permit. It is understood that in the event of weather conditions that put the City at risk of fire danger (ex. KBDI Index exceeds 600) or in the event of a burn ban, this permit becomes null and void, no refund will be issued, and that any violation of the residential firework discharge permit regulations may result in a fine, confiscation of permit, and/or confiscation of fireworks.
