

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 125-8.2.3, ENTITLED "PERMIT" TO EXEMPT CERTAIN SIGNS AND BANNERS ON ATHLETIC STADIUMS AND FACILITIES FROM SIGN REGEULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 125-8.2.3, entitled "Permit" is amended to add subsection (c) as follows:

125-8.2.3 Permit. No sign structure shall be erected, altered, displayed, or relocated without first obtaining a permit from the City of League City. In addition, to the permit required; electrical signs also require electrical permits under the electrical code. No permit or fee is required for the follow types of signs:

- a. Traffic control signs on private property which do not exceed four and one-half square feet in area or no higher than three feet.
- b. Menu Boards that are a maximum of eight feet in height and do not exceed 72 sq. ft. in area. Only two menu boards are permitted per drive-through.
- c. Signs placed on buildings, walls or fences facing the interior and/or the exterior of athletic stadiums, courts or fields owned or operated by governmental entities, including school districts. These signs are exempt from the requirements of this Article.

Section 2. Savings. All rights and remedies which have accrued in favor of the City under this Ordinance and amendments thereto shall be and are preserved for the benefit of the City.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Codification. It is the intent of the City Council of the City of League City, Texas, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be codified in the City's official Code of Ordinances as

provided hereinabove.

Section 6. Publication and Effective Date. The City Secretary shall cause this Ordinance, or its caption, to be published in the official newspaper of the City of League City, upon passage of such Ordinance. The Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
