John, Rick,

The 24 inch Ductile Iron Force Main from East Main LS has a substantial leak just west of Genco Canal along WB FM 2094. The leak is substantial and is compromising the FM 2094 roadway. Additionally, East Main LS is a General Benefit Facility that collects 12 lift stations and we can only bypass a <u>small portion</u> of the total capacity needed to ensure adequate conveyance during peak rainfall events. All said, we are moving forward on an Emergency basis due to the aforementioned concerns and the potential threat to Public Health and Safety.

Wagner Construction was able to mobilize on site today and will prepare to start excavation and repair activities as soon as possible. Wagner was able to provide a 6 inch bypass setup yesterday and wet haul tanker are also on site to manage flow as best as possible during the ongoing rain periods.

Estimated FM repair cost and this is high level at best...\$75-\$150K. Repair location and access should make cost lower than the recent Smith Lane FM repairs. Replacing roadway to TxDOT standards...???.

Will update as things progress.
