Bleachers, seating, or stands shall not be erected on the roadway.

No alcoholic beverages may be sold or consumed by participants on a City street.

The planning of the event shall include participation of Public Safety Departments and other City Departments as needed to insure comprehensive and thoroughness.

This permit is only authorized for city streets inside the municipal boundaries and jurisdictional boundaries of the City of League City. The permittee is only authorized to travel on the following public roadways, E. Walker Street. See map for approved route.

The permittee shall attend all barricades and at no time shall prohibit the access to and from any residence or business. No setup equipment, vehicles, or person shall block the ingress or regress of emergency vehicles.

The League City Police Department will provide personnel for traffic management.

Additionally, the organizer shall arrange for any cleanup of the City streets and rights-of-way from debris accumulated as a result from the distribution of paper flyers, banners, or food products by the participant.
