

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$44,277 WITH TEXAS-NEW MEXICO POWER (TNMP) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF STREET LIGHTING ALONG FM 2094 (ST2602) AS PART OF THE FY2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the FM 2094 Street Lighting Project (ST2602) is included in the City's adopted FY2026 Capital Improvement Program and is intended to enhance corridor visibility and improve nighttime safety along approximately 17,000 linear feet of FM 2094 from the intersection of FM 518/FM 270 to the City's eastern city limits; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the project consists of installing luminaires on existing utility poles within the corridor, and Texas-New Mexico Power (TNMP) has identified 46 existing power poles within its service area where 200-watt equivalent LED luminaires may be installed; and

WHEREAS, TNMP has provided a unit cost estimate of \$837 per luminaire, and Staff recommends applying a 15% contingency to address potential transformer and material variability, resulting in an adjusted unit cost of \$963 per luminaire and a total estimated expenditure not to exceed \$44,277 for Phase 1 within the TNMP service area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City authorizes an expenditure in an amount not to exceed Forty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Seven and No/100 Dollars (\$44,277.00) with Texas-New Mexico Power for the installation of 46 LED luminaires on existing utility poles along FM 2094 as part of the FY2026 Capital Improvement Program.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any agreements and related documents necessary to effectuate the installation of the luminaires described herein.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
