

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD FOR THE DICKINSON BAYOU FLOOD MITIGATION PROJECT; AUTHORIZING A GRANT AGREEMENT, ESCROW AGREEMENT, AND ALL RELATED CLOSING DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of League City, Texas (the “City”) participated in the Lower Clear Creek and Dickinson Bayou Watershed Study completed in 2021, which identified regional flood mitigation projects within the Dickinson Bayou watershed; and

WHEREAS, such projects were subsequently incorporated into the State Flood Plan for Texas (Region 6), and require further study and evaluation to assess feasibility, benefits, and implementation strategies; and

WHEREAS, one such project alternative, known as “Dickinson Bayou Alternative 2,” includes multiple regional detention basins and a channel diversion project within southwest League City; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Alternative 2 study is approximately \$1,080,000 and includes the following components: McFarland Road Detention Basin, West Cemetery Road Detention Basin, Hilton Lane Detention Basin, Magnolia Bayou and Borden Gully Detention Basins, and the Desel Drive channel diversion; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted an application to the Texas Water Development Board Flood Infrastructure Fund in March 2024 seeking financial assistance to support further study of these projects; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2026, the Texas Water Development Board approved the City’s request for financial assistance in the form of a grant in the amount of \$545,000 (Project No. 40219); and

WHEREAS, such grant funding is subject to the execution of a grant agreement with the Texas Water Development Board and the satisfaction of certain closing requirements, including execution of an escrow agreement and related documents; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of such grant funding will enable the City to advance regional flood mitigation planning and position the City to pursue future large-scale capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that acceptance of such funding and execution of the required agreements is in the best interest of the City and its residents and will further the City’s strategic goal of developing and maintaining critical infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby accepts grant funding in the amount of \$545,000 from

the Texas Water Development Board Flood Infrastructure Fund for the Dickinson Bayou Flood Mitigation Project (Project No. 40219).

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes a grant agreement, an escrow agreement, and all related closing documents associated therewith.

Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and deliver all documents related to this transaction and to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
