

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH LAND AND SEA SERVICES 1, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A REPLACEMENT EMERGENCY STANDBY GENERATOR AT THE GLEN COVE LIFT STATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$78,937.00; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of League City operates the Glen Cove Lift Station and requires reliable emergency standby generator capacity to support continued lift station operations during power outages; and

WHEREAS, the existing 175 kW generator at the Glen Cove Lift Station remains operational, but its sound levels have resulted in increasing concerns as residential development has occurred near the lift station; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommend replacing the existing generator with a new 150 kW Cummins diesel standby generator equipped with a Level 2 sound-attenuated enclosure and relocating the existing 175 kW generator to the Vehicle Maintenance Facility to extend the useful life of an existing City asset; and

WHEREAS, City staff obtained competitive quotations and recommend awarding the contract to Land and Sea Services 1, Inc. as the lowest responsive quotation meeting the City's project needs.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The facts and opinions stated in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 2. The City authorizes a contract with Land and Sea Services 1, Inc. for the purchase and installation of a replacement emergency standby generator at the Glen Cove Lift Station, relocation of the existing 175 kW generator to the Vehicle Maintenance Facility, and related installation, crane, monitoring, startup, and testing services in an amount not to exceed \$78,937.00; and an executed copy of the contract shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents and take all actions necessary to complete the transaction, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 4. All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
