

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO LDC PAVING INCORPORATED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$73,750 FOR PAVEMENT PRESERVATION SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING UP TO \$25,000 FOR TARGETED ASPHALT REPAIRS AT THE CITY HALL, CITY HALL ANNEX, CIVIC CENTER, AND LIBRARY PARKING LOTS, FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$98,750

WHEREAS, the parking lots serving City Hall, City Hall Annex, the Civic Center, and the Library have experienced normal wear and deterioration, including cracking, pavement failures, potholes, and surface deterioration, creating a need for targeted asphalt repairs and pavement preservation services; and

WHEREAS, the proposed work includes localized asphalt repairs and application of a Liquid Road pavement preservation treatment, which is intended to extend the useful life of the asphalt and reduce future maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with City policy, City staff obtained and evaluated quotes from qualified vendors and recommends awarding the pavement preservation services and targeted asphalt repair work to LDC Paving Incorporated as providing the best value to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The facts and opinions in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct.

Section 2. The City authorizes a contract to LDC Paving Incorporated in the amount of \$73,750 for pavement preservation services and authorizes up to \$25,000 for targeted asphalt repairs at the City Hall, City Hall Annex, Civic Center, and Library parking lots, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$98,750; and an executed copy of the contract is attached as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
