

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SANDER ENGINEERING CORPORATION FOR DESIGN, BID, AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES RELATED TO THE BAY COLONY 2 PARKSIDE LIFT STATION RELOCATION PROJECT (WW2601) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$247,388

WHEREAS, the City of League City maintains wastewater infrastructure necessary to serve the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Grand Parkway (SH 99) IH 45 westbound Direct Connector project will require acquisition of the existing Bay Colony 2 Parkside Lift Station site and associated access easement by the Texas Department of Transportation, necessitating relocation of the facility; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has issued a Notice of Required Accommodation (NORA) to initiate preliminary utility relocation activities, with a future Standard Utility Agreement anticipated to provide for reimbursement of eligible relocation costs; and

WHEREAS, Sander Engineering Corporation has submitted a proposal to provide preliminary and final design, bid phase, and construction phase services for the relocation project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the selection of Sander Engineering Corporation for these professional services is in the best interest of the City and consistent with applicable procurement requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes a professional services agreement with Sander Engineering Corporation for design, bid, and construction phase services related to the Bay Colony 2 Parkside Lift Station Relocation Project (WW2601), in an amount not to exceed \$247,388; and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
