We are reaching out in support of League City citizens opposed to the 646/Caroline BESS site.

While we understand the growing shortage of power and the demand it has on the Texas grid, we do not agree with decisions being made without more due diligence by LC Council.

There are too many issues still of grave concern to LC residents to vote yes.

- CCR is a young company that has already proven to have very poor customer service response and have employee reports of high turnover, lack of training and funding issues.
- Due to this being new technology there is not enough operational data to ensure safety, performance and risk analysis are reliable.
- Should CCR be chosen, we still oppose sites being built next to neighborhoods and schools.
- Materials being sole sourced from China, as confirmed by CCR, increase cybersecurity threat.
- True risk of fires (and worse) are unproven, firefighting measures may then be unreliable putting LC citizens at even greater risk.

These are just some of the concerns we have, but which are more than enough that LC Council should vote NO at this time until thorough due diligence can be completed.
