

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A SIX-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC., UNDER TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES (DIR) CONTRACT NO. DIR-CPO-5433, FOR DRONE AS FIRST RESPONDER (DFR) CAPABILITIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,759,980; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Drone as First Responder (DFR) technology has the potential to enhance public safety by improving emergency response times, increasing situational awareness, and providing additional operational capabilities to police and fire personnel; and

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions, Inc. has proposed providing DFR capabilities through its partnership with BRINC under a six-year agreement that includes an initial one-year waiver of subscription fees, allowing the City to evaluate the technology before the first paid subscription year, with the option to terminate the agreement before annual subscription fees begin; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement will be procured through Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract No. DIR-CPO-5433, a cooperative purchasing contract authorized by Texas law, thereby satisfying applicable competitive procurement requirements for the acquisition of the products and services provided under the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that authorizing the proposed agreement is in the best interest of the City and its residents and will allow the City to evaluate the effectiveness of Drone as First Responder capabilities while preserving the City's contractual right to terminate the agreement before the first paid subscription year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct, are adopted as findings of the City Council for all purposes, and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The City authorizes a six-year agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc., under Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Contract No. DIR-CPO-5433, for Drone as First Responder (DFR) capabilities in an amount not to exceed One Million Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$1,759,980), attached and incorporated as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement and all related documents necessary to implement this Resolution.

Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
