ORDINANCE NO. 2024-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY ENTITLED "PARKS AND RECREATION" BY AMENDING SECTION 74-131, ENTITLED "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN CITY PARKS" TO CLARIFY THAT ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED AT THE BALLPARK AT LEAGUE CITY (FORMERLY BIG LEAGUE DREAMS), PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to AMEND Article IV, Chapter 74 of the League City Code of Ordinances to read as follows (<u>additions</u>, <u>deletions</u>):

Sec. 74-131. Alcoholic beverages in city parks.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or consume any alcoholic beverage at:
 - (1) Hometown Heroes Park, the Chester Davis Sportsplex, Lobit Park, or Walker Street Pool unless authorized by a permit issued pursuant to this article; or
 - (2) <u>Unless at the Ballpark at League City</u>, any park owned or operated by the city while attending any organized youth sports competition.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or offer for sale any alcoholic beverage in a city park without first obtaining a permit pursuant to this article.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Savings. All rights and remedies which have accrued in favor of the Cityunder this Ordinance and amendments thereto shall be and are preserved for the benefit of the City.
 - <u>Section 3.</u> Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
 - <u>Section 4.</u> Repealer. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict.
 - Section 5. Codification. It is the intent of the City Council of the City of League City,

Texas, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be codified in the City's official Code of Ordinances as provided hereinabove.

<u>Section 6.</u> Publication and Effective Date. The City Secretary shall cause this Ordinance, or its caption, to be published in the official newspaper of the City of League City, upon passage of such Ordinance. This Ordinance shall become effective on passage.
