

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES, MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY, TO SEEK FUNDING THROUGH THE CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFT PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM TO BENEFIT THE LEAGUE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S DRONE AS FIRST RESPONDER ("DFR") PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH GRANT IF AWARDED

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement taskforces and agencies for economic motor vehicle theft, including catalytic converter theft; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant program will assist the City of League City ("City") to combat catalytic converter theft; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City that the Police Department's DFR Program be operated to combat economic motor vehicle theft, including but not limited to theft of catalytic converters, burglary of motor vehicles, and fraud-related motor vehicle crime; and

**WHEREAS**, the City agrees to provide applicable matching funds for said grant as required by the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the City agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, the City agrees and assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the City designates the Chief of Police as the Authorized Official. The Authorized Official is given the power to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City designates the Director of Finance as the Financial Officer and the Police Captain as the Program Director for this grant.

**NOW THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The facts and opinions in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct.

Section 2. The City authorizes the Police Department to submit a grant application to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority, to seek funding, not to exceed \$150,000, through the Catalytic Converter Theft Prevention Grant

Program to benefit the League City Police Department's DFR Program; and authorizes the acceptance of such grant if awarded.

Section 3. The City designates the Chief of Police as the Authorized Official, the Director of Finance as the Financial Officer, and the Police Captain as the Program Director for this grant, who are authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction, accept any grant funding, and monitor the program, as required by the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.

Section 6. The City agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said grant, as required, and agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.
