A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGECNY (FEMA) FOR THREE (3) RESIDENTIAL ELEVATION PROJECTS AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SUCH A GRANT IF AWARDED

WHEREAS, the Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA) grant program is funded by FEMA and administered by the Texas Water Development Board for the State of Texas on behalf of FEMA and provides federal funds at a minimum of 75% of the costs associated with the project;

WHEREAS, the FMA grant program requires property owners to work through local governments to submit applications and property owners at 2108 Knollwood Street, 2114 Cove Park Drive, and 2118 Cove Park Drive have agreed to provide the applicable matching funds required and requested the City's assistance in submitting their applications;

WHEREAS, the City will submit one comprehensive application for 2108 Knollwood Street, 2114 Cove Park Drive, and 2118 Cove Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City will act as the grant administrator for the projects if awarded and the City's costs are to be refunded under the terms of the grant.

NOW, THEREEFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City authorizes the submission of a grant application to the Flood Mitigation Assistance grant program under the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for three (3) residential elevation projects and authorizes the acceptance of such a grant if awarded.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager or designee, Christopher Sims, is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction and accept any grant funding.

<u>Section 3.</u> All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.

<u>Section 5.</u> The property owners agree to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required and the City agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the funds will be returned in full to FEMA.
