Rick,

The attached quote summary applies to the East Main Force Main Emergency By-Pass required to address an active sanitary sewer leak on the existing 24 inch force main. This force main serves a large portion of the City's eastside service area and collects wastewater from 8 lift stations. The current leak is contained currently but further progression is inevitable and could jeopardize the FM 2094 roadway along with posing a potential threat to public health & safety. The by-pass also allows the Contractor constructing the on-going Capital Improvement Project to build the replacement force main without delays caused from additional failures of the 40 year old pipe.

That said, I am requesting authorization to move forward on an emergency basis which will allow Xylem and Faith Utilities to mobilize on Wednesday, October 8th to begin by-pass construction on a fast-track basis. Construction of the bypass is expected to take 9 days and the by-pass will be in place for approximately 90-120 days. Business access, pedestrian walk paths, and temporary lane closures are being coordinated with CCISD, TxDOT, Bayou Brae residents and local businesses.
