A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CITY OF FRIENDSWOOD RELATED TO THE HARRIS COUNTY PRECINCT 2 GRANT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT BAY AREA BOULEVARD AND GRISSOM ROAD

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2024, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2024-090 authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) between the City of League City and the City of Friendswood for participation in the Harris County Precinct 2 Grant Partnership Program for the design and construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Bay Area Boulevard and Grissom Road, with an estimated total project cost of \$500,000, of which Harris County would fund 50% and the remaining 50% would be shared equally by the two cities; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to execution of the original MOU, the total project cost estimate has been refined to \$650,000, and Harris County has agreed to increase its contribution proportionally to \$325,000, representing 50% of the revised project cost, with the remaining 50% to continue to be shared equally between the City of League City and the City of Friendswood, increasing each city’s contribution to \$162,500; and

WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment to the MOU updates the cost allocations to reflect the revised project estimate while maintaining the original cost-sharing percentages, roles, and responsibilities, including Harris County serving as the managing partner responsible for design, implementation, integration into its traffic control assets, and long-term maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City hereby approves the First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Friendswood related to the Harris County Precinct 2 Grant Partnership Program for the traffic signal at Bay Area Boulevard and Grissom Road; and an executed copy of the amendment is attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
