

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ARDURRA GROUP, INC. FOR DESIGN, BID, AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES RELATED TO THE SH 3 BOOSTER PUMP STATION CHEMICAL FEED BUILDING AND STORAGE PROJECT (WT2402) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$525,000

WHEREAS, the SH 3 Booster Pump Station is a critical component of the City's potable water distribution system, supplying water through multiple transmission lines and supporting service to the eastern portion of the City; and

WHEREAS, the existing trailer-based portable chemical feed system installed in 2014 as a temporary solution lacks sufficient storage capacity and chemical boosting capability to consistently maintain disinfectant residuals and meet regulatory requirements, particularly during periods of high demand; and

WHEREAS, in 2025 the City engaged a consultant to evaluate the existing system and develop alternatives, and such evaluation determined that a Sodium Hypochlorite-Liquid Ammonia Sulphate (LAS) system housed within a permanent building provides a safer and more economical long-term solution with adequate storage, monitoring, and safety systems; and

WHEREAS, the proposed SH 3 Booster Pump Station Chemical Feed Building and Storage Project (WT2402) will improve system reliability, enhance regulatory compliance, and increase capacity to meet current and future water production demands, including the ultimate design capacity of approximately 43.9 MGD; and

WHEREAS, Ardurra Group, Inc. has submitted a proposal to provide design, bid, and construction phase services for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$525,000, and funding for such services is available in the Utility Capital Project Fund, Fund 1055, Project WT2402;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The Professional Services Agreement between the City of League City and Ardurra Group, Inc. for design, bid, and construction phase services related to the SH 3 Booster Pump Station Chemical Feed Building and Storage Project (WT2402), in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$525,000), is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Professional Services Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A," together with any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only. All exhibits attached to this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein for all purposes as if fully set forth in their entirety

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
