

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING (1) A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH DELTA FIRE FOR THE PURCHASE OF AT LEAST THIRTY-TWO (32) SETS OF BUNKER GEAR IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$483,552.00, AND (2) A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH FIRE-DEX FOR THE CLEANING, INSPECTION, REPAIR, AND RENTAL OF BUNKER GEAR IN A COMBINED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$132,300.00

WHEREAS, on December 23, 2025, the City released ITB 26-018 for Bunker Gear Purchase, Rental, Cleaning, Inspection, and Repair, and three (3) bids were received in response thereto; and

WHEREAS, Delta Fire is the only bidder offering bunker gear for purchase and is recommended for award of the purchase contract in an amount not to exceed \$483,552.00 for a minimum of thirty-two (32) sets of bunker gear, and Fire-Dex is recommended for award of the cleaning, inspection, repair, and rental services as the lowest responsive bidder for rental services and as providing the best overall value when bundling such services; and

WHEREAS, bunker gear constitutes required personal protective equipment for firefighters, must be removed from service ten (10) years after the date of manufacture in accordance with Texas Commission on Fire Protection regulations, and the proposed agreements ensure continued regulatory compliance and operational readiness in furtherance of the City's Strategic Planning Critical Success Factor #3, Safe and Desirable Community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City hereby authorizes a three-year agreement with Delta Fire for the purchase of at least thirty-two (32) sets of bunker gear in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars (\$483,552.00); and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City hereby authorizes a three-year agreement with Fire-Dex for the cleaning, inspection, repair, and rental of bunker gear in a combined amount not to exceed One Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$132,300.00); and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit B.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
