Subject: FW: On-gong Sanitary Sewer Emergency Repairs

John, Rick,

I wanted to provide you a quick update on the on-going emergency sanitary sewer repairs.

- 1) The 12-inch Gravity Line repair at Walker St. and FM 646 is complete. The contractor and utility line repair staff worked through the night this Thursday to complete the cured in-place pipe installation, with no service interruption.
- 2) Work related to the Smith Lane Lift Station repairs continues to be manageable but difficult. By the end of today the three bypasses needed to perform the repairs will be complete and operational. The Contractor will mobilize heavy equipment this coming Monday to begin replacing a failed incoming 24-inch gravity trunk that enters the wet well structure and failed 20 force main. Expected repair duration increased to 10-14 days due to the additional failed deep gravity line.

City Utilities Staff will continue to operate and monitor bypass pumps 24/7 through the completion of the repairs to ensure no loss of service.

Subject: On-gong Sanitary Sewer Emergency Repairs

Gentlemen,

Public Works is currently working with multiple contractors on two emergency sanitary sewer repairs. The scope of work for both repairs is outside of in-house capabilities. Both repairs are being approached as “Emergency status” due to the complexity of the repairs and the large service areas they serve.

Repair descriptions:

- 1) 12 inch Gravity Sewer (GS) failure at Walker St. and FM 646- The failed GS serves approximately 84 businesses near FM 646 and I-45 and is extremely difficult to bypass pump. The pipe failure is 16 feet deep and located near the roadway edge along with being in a highly congested area of multiple utilities. Excavation is not an option at this time. The method of repair selected is Cured In-place Pipe (CIPP). The cost estimate is approximately \$30,000 and we hope to have the contractor mobilized this coming Thursday night.
- 2) Smith Lane Lift Station 20-inch Force Main failure – The failed force main serves approximately 40 percent of the eastside service area and will require a substantial and difficult bypass pumping setup before the repairs can be made. Repair costs will include wet hauling (tankers) until bypass pumping setup is complete, By-pass pump rental and set-up, Construction of bypass (20 inch DI fittings), Failed 20 Inch Pipe replacement, and site restoration. Rough estimate at this time is \$100,000 to \$150,000+and certainly subject to change as we progress forward. Expected duration 5-7days.
