**SCHOOL AND PARTICIPATING AGENCY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
FOR COMMUNITY-BASED VOCATIONAL INSTRUCTION**

INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE:

The purpose of community-based instruction is to provide students with real life, functional experiences in a natural environment during on-site vocational training. The setting at

(Name of Business, herein cited as the Business)

Will provide students with an opportunity to participate in this type of training. Through participation in community-based vocational training, students will have many training experiences as part of their career development. The students will receive training in the acquisition of vocational, communication, functional academic, social and adaptive behavior skills while in the community. Because of the nature of this program, the training sites become extensions of the classroom and are instructional environments for the students.

No immediate economic gain will be derived by the Business. The purpose of the program is to benefit the students. Although students will be under direct supervision of the assigned school staff, an employee of the Business may assist a student trainee. It is understood that the student trainees may occasionally impede or interfere with an employee's ability to complete his job duties. Employees will not suffer job loss or reduction of hours due to students training at the Business.

STUDENTS:

All students involved in on-site training at the Business and enrolled in the community-based vocational instructional program at their enrolled high school campus. School will be accompanied to the Business by at least one certified teacher or paraprofessional job coach employed by the Clear Creek Independent School District.



TIME:

Days and hours will be agreed upon by the Business and the special education teacher and will not exceed normal academic schedules.

REMUNERATION:

All students participating in vocational training at the Business are considered to be in a classroom vocational program; therefore, they are not employees of the Business. No remuneration is requested. Additionally, students are not covered by the Business's Worker's Compensation insurance. Students or their parents have been informed of this vocational program and are aware of the training nature of this activity.

TRAINING SITES:

The exact type of training and location of the training stations will be agreed upon by the Business and the special education teacher after an inventory of training tasks is completed by the special education teacher.

EMPLOYMENT:

The Business is under no obligation to hire any student participating in this program.

We the undersigned, as representatives of our agency or business, agree to abide by the statements listed above. We understand that this agreement may be canceled by either party upon notice to the other.
