

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DELEGATION TO CERTAIN CITY OFFICERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL'S AUTHORITY TO APPROVE CERTAIN CONTRACTS FOR BUDGETED ITEMS.

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14 of the City's Home Rule Charter allows the City Council to confer upon a City officer the authority to contract for budgeted expenditures without further approval of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such delegation of contracting authority would improve the efficiency and operations of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1 The facts and opinions in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct.

Section 2. The authority of City officers to enter into contracts for budgeted items without further approval of the City Council, as set forth in the Purchasing Policy of the City of League City attached as "Exhibit A" hereto, is hereby approved.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective as of the date of its passage.

Section 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.
