Traffic Control Plan - General

CityWide Wellness Walk/Run 1/5 kilometer route will run through the League City Historic District. This route will need to be closed to vehicular traffic for the duration of the event.

Traffic Control Plan - Staging

Staging will begin no earlier than 7:30 am and be completed no later than 9:00am. Traffic control personnel will be on station by 8:30 am.

Traffic Control Plan - Drop-Off Points

Parking available along Railroad Avenue

Traffic Control Plan - Route

The route will allow for independent walk/run traffic beginning at the League Park, 512 Second Street. Starting point at Second Street and Park Street (by Fire station #1) and ending by League Park pavilion.

Intersections are as follows:

1K Route

- a. Continue on Second Street, past Michigan, Colorado and Kansas Avenues
- b. Left on N. Iowa Avenue
- c. Left on 3rd Street
- d. Left on N. Park Ave

5K Route

- e. Continue on Second Street, past Michigan, Colorado and Kansas Avenues
- f. Left on N. Iowa Avenue
- g. Right on 3rd Street, past N. Illinois Avenue
- h. Left on Wisconsin
- i. Right on Coryell
- j. Left on Landrum
- k. Right onto 7th Street. Right on Alabama Ave
- m. Turn around point at Alabama Ave and Coryell
- n. Left on Seventh Street
- o. Left on Landrum
- p. Right on Coryell St
- q. Left on N. Wisconsin
- r. Right on 3rd Streets. Left on N. Park Ave
