**A.** Hold a public hearing and take action on a Zone Change Application, **Z15-16** (**Bradshaw Nursery**), a request to rezone approximately 0.75 acres from "OS" (Open Space) to "RSF-7" (Single Family Residential with a minimum lot size of 7,000 square feet), legally described as Lots 35-37, Block 4 of The Oaks of Clear Creek, Section 2, generally located north of League City Parkway and west of Bradshaw Nursery Road.

Ryan Granata, Planning Manager, presented for the City of League City.

City staff recommends approval because the proposed rezoning is similar classification of the area.
