Mr. Smith, here is Txdot recommendation, The study is based on the 85th Percentile Method which represents the speed of the majority of drivers driving at the maximum safe speed. Although the study appears to be higher than the 85th Percentile, the speed limit can be lowered down to 10 MPH below the 85th Percentile Method due to the following existing conditions:

1. Residential Area
2. Developed Area
3. Number of driveways and other developments.

The study indicates most vehicles comply with speed limit signage, but you attached a sample ordinance that states a 45 mph limit throughout the section.

Does TxDOT recommend that the speed limit be 45 mph as shown in the ordinance?? If so, can you state that specifically in a letter or email?

Certainly SH96 is quickly becoming an "urban section" and 45 mph may be appropriate; just need good justification to deviate from speed study.
