Mr. Smith, here is Txdot recommendation, The study is based on the 85<sup>th</sup> Percentile Method which represents the speed of the majority of drivers driving at the maximum safe speed. Although the study appears to be higher than the 85<sup>th</sup> Percentile, the speed limit can be lowered down to 10 MPH below the 85<sup>th</sup> Percentile Method due to the following existing conditions:

- 1. Residential Area
- 2. Developed Area
- 3. Number of driveways and other developments.
