Title

Consider and take action to approve the award of Bid 13-014 for Sludge Transportation and Disposal to Republic Services (Director of Finance)

Staff recommends approval

..Background:

Presently, the City's three wastewater treatment facilities produce an average monthly yield of approximately 75,000 gallons (15 loads) per month of liquid biosolids (sludge), which is tanker transported and 150 dry tons (50 loads) of de-watered biosolids (sludge cake) which is roll-off transported. The sludge cake is transported for disposal from the Southwest Water Reclamation Facility (SWWRF), and the Dallas Salmon Wastewater Treatment Plant (DSWWTP), to a Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) permitted co-disposal landfill. Liquid sludge is transferred for dewatering from the Countryside Wastewater Treatment Plant (CSWWTP), to DSWWTP, approximately six miles one way, and/or to SWWRF, approximately three miles one way. Wastewater treatment generated sludge must be disposed of in accordance with TCEQ regulations.

The City's existing contract with Sprint Logistics, which has hauled League City's sludge since 2009, is to expire at the end of March 2013. On March 14, 2013, two bids were received for the annual contract for Sludge Transportation and Disposal. Using approximate quantities as stated above the results of a price comparison showed Republic Services price as being the best value for the City.

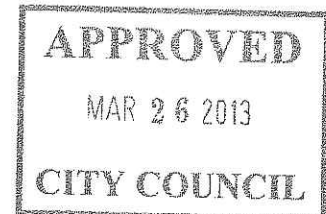

Republic Services has over 20 years experience in the hauling and disposing of municipal and industrial sludge, and meets all the requirements/specifications of this service. Based on price and their ability to meet specifications, the recommendation is to award the contract for sludge transportation and disposal to Republic Services. This is a one year contract with a one-year option for renewal.

The FY 2013 budgeted funds for this service is \$397,645.

Title

Consider and take action to approve a one-year renewal, of the award of Bid #13-014, for Sludge Transportation and Disposal to Republic Services at an estimated annual cost of \$270,000 (Director of Finance)

..Background:

Approval of this item will provide for a one-year final term of the existing contract with Republic Services for the transportation and disposal of sludge from the City's three wastewater treatment facilities at current pricing.

The City's wastewater facilities produce an average monthly yield of approximately 75,000 gallons/ 15 loads per month of liquid biosolids (sludge), which is tanker transported and 150 dry tons/ 50 loads of de-watered biosolids (sludge cake) which is roll-off transported. The sludge cake is transported for disposal from the Southwest Water Reclamation Facility (SWWRF), and the Dallas Salmon Wastewater Treatment Plant (DSWWTP), to a Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) permitted co-disposal landfill. Liquid sludge is transferred for dewatering from the Countryside Wastewater Treatment Plant (CSWWTP), to DSWWTP, approximately six (6) miles one way, and/or to SWWRF, approximately three (3) miles one way. Wastewater treatment generated sludge must be disposed of in accordance with TCEQ regulations.

On March 14, 2013, the City received two (2) bids for this service. On March 26, 2013, Council approved a one (1) year contract with Republic Services for Sludge Transportation and Disposal and was subsequently renewed for a one (1) year period on June 10, 2014. This contract may be renewed for a final one (1) year period upon the mutual agreement of both parties. This service will be rebid in early spring of 2016.

Republic has agreed to hold current pricing on all items for an additional year at the original pricing submitted in 2013. Republic has provided good service and has handled the City's service in a timely and adequate manner.

Based on price, quality of service, and satisfaction of City personnel, the recommendation is to renew this contract with Republic Services through May 31, 2016, and re advertise for the next service year.
