## 2. WORK SESSION TO DISCUSS THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FY 2016-2017

Mark Rohr, City Manager, said we are following the same format that we have followed the last two years. It has gone very well and very efficient. As I indicated in the memo that I sent to Council we are starting to get backed up in terms of work session agenda items and I gave you an idea of what is coming up for this next one. With that thought in mind we thought we would try to go through this as quickly as we can tonight and get through as much as we can. Ideally I would like to get through three-quarters of the book. As each section is called the respective director, department head and other personnel that can answer questions will come up and be prepared to respond to your questions.

The following departmental budgets were reviewed:

Administrative Directorate - City Council, City Manager, City Secretary, City Attorney, City Auditor, Information Technology, Public Safety Technology Fund, Human Resources/Civil Services, Economic Development, Hotel/Motel Occupancy Tax Fund.

Finance Directorate – Accounting and Financial Planning, Municipal Court, Purchasing, Municipal Security Fund (special revenue fund), Utility Billing

Police Directorate – Police, Animal Control, Animal Control Donation Fund, Police Activity Fund

Fire Directorate – Fire Department, Fire Marshal, Emergency Medical Services, Emergency Management

Public Works Directorate – Public Works Administration, Water Department, Engineering Department, Street and Traffic, Facilities Maintenance, Solid Waste, Wastewater, Line Repair, Fleet

Planning and Development Directorate – Planning, Building, Neighborhood Services, Tree Preservation Fund

Parks and Cultural Services Directorate – Library, Library Gift Fund, Civic Center Operations, Park Operations, Park Recreation

4B Park Maintenance and Operations – Special Revenue Fund

Mark Rohr, City Manager said we got a lot done tonight, we got all of the operational budget reviewed. We have a few specific areas that are mainly transfers and CIP's and things that we still have to go over but we made a lot of progress and freed up a lot of time in the future for other things.
