### 2. PUBLIC HEARING AND ACTION ITEMS FROM PUBLIC HEARING

2A. 16-1252

Hold a public hearing on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by 13 percent. This is the first of two required public hearings. The City Council will vote to adopt the tax rate on October 4, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. at Council Chambers, 200 West Walker, League City, TX 77573 (Assistant City Manager)

Mayor Hallisey opened the public hearing at 6:01 p.m.

Rebecca Underhill, Assistant City Manager, said just wanted to introduce why we are here tonight. On September 6, the City Council adopted a proposed tax rate of 57.35 cents per \$100 valuation. That is the same tax rate as has been effective for the current year. The rate exceeds the effective tax rate, which the effective tax rate for this year is 55.086 cents per \$100 valuation. Because the proposed rate exceeds the effective tax rate, additional notices and hearings were required by law and this is the first of two public hearings. The notice was published on September 12 in the Galveston County Daily News. The second public hearing is scheduled for next Tuesday at 6:00 p.m. and the Council is scheduled to vote on October 4 at a special meeting at 5:30 p.m. Also, I wanted to let the public know that the Council has adopted the budget on September 13. So that action has already been taken.
