## CITATION FLOW CHART



**CITATION ISSUED** – Defendant is given 20 business days to appear to pay fines or sign for court date. If a traffic violation is issued, Defendants also have the options to sign up for Defensive Driving or Deferred Adjudication.



Defendant appear s by due date to handle their citations.

Citation is finalized.

**SCOFFLAW:** This will initiate a hold to be placed on vehicle registrations for all Traffic Violations until fines are paid.



Defendant fails to appear by original due date.

Defendant receives a **BLACKBOARD CONNECT** phone call notifying defendant of their past due citation.

Warrant is issued within 7 days,

**BLACKBOARD CONNECT** phone call sent to defendant, warrant postcard mailed out notifying defendant of their active warrants.

Information imported into **OMNI**:

information is sent to DPS to place a hold on driver's license until fines are paid, **SETCIC**: a tool to notify agencies state wide of accurate & timely documented criminal information,

**Warrant Officer** attempts to serve warrants within 30 miles of League City.

60 days – Outstanding warrants are imported to **Linebarger:** fines & court costs are increased by 30%, collection letters are mailed to defendants, along with various phone calls placed notifying defendant of their active warrants. Linebarger actively locates additional/new addresses & phone numbers. During Warrant Round Up, Linebarger sends notices to all active warrants in their database.

This is a Zero cost collection function. Linebarger is paid the 30% additional fee.
