This First Amendment ("Amendment") is entered between the City of League City ("City") and Meador Staffing Services, Inc. ("Contractor") on the date set forth below.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2016, the City and Contractor entered into an agreement for temporary employment services ("Agreement); and

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor wish to amend the terms of the Agreement to extend the contract term to September 31, 2018 and increase the total compensation paid under Agreement to \$170,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree to the following terms.

TERMS

- 1. The above-listed recitals are true and correct and hereby incorporated into this Amendment.
- 2. The last sentence of Section 5.G of the Agreement shall be replaced in its entirety with the following language:

The total compensation paid to MSS by the City shall not exceed \$170,000 throughout the term of this contract.

3. Section 7 of the Agreement shall be replaced in its entirety with the following language:

Term of the Agreement. The term of this contract shall begin on September 1, 2016 and end on September 31, 2018, with the option to renew for 1 additional one year term. Either party may terminate this agreement in writing with 30 days' notice to the relevant address listed in Section 9 Notices.

- 4. Except as expressly provided in this Amendment, all other terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect as provided therein.
- 5. The Agreement is hereby incorporated by reference into this Amendment.
