1. <u>CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS</u>

Mayor Hallisey called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and called the roll. All members of Council were present except Mr. Dugie.

3. FIRST READING OF ORDINANCES

3A. 17-0520

Consider and take action on an ordinance approving an ad valorem tax rate for the City of League City, Texas, upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2018; directing the assessment and collection thereof; providing for a severability clause; and providing for an effective date (Assistant City Manager)

Staff requests first and final reading.

A motion was made by Mr. Kinsey, seconded by Mr. Long, to approve first and final reading of this ordinance. The motion passed by the following vote:

Staff requests first and final reading.

A motion was made by Mr. Becker, seconded by Mr. Long, to approve Ordinance No, 2017-27 approving an ad valorem tax rate for the City of League City, Texas, upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2018, directing the assessment and collection thereof, providing for a severability clause; and providing for an effective date.

Mayor Hallisey read the exact verbiage from the data sheet that the motion needs to include to adopt the tax rate. Mr. Becker and Mr. Long agreed to include in their motion "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$.056500 which is effectively a 2.8% increase in the tax rate".

A motion to amend was made by Mr. Kinsey, seconded by Mr. Millican, that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$.57 which is probably effectively a 3% increase in the tax rate.

Bo Bass, Assistant City Manager, said it is my understanding that if you choose to increase above \$0.56500, the previously discussed tax rate, you would have to renotify and initiate the public hearing process again. One thing that is a bit of a rub in that regard is that as I understand it we are required to adopt the tax rate by October 20.

After further discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Kinsey to call the question.

At 5:45 Mayor Hallisey called for a five minute break for a procedural clarification from the City Attorney. The City Attorney clarified that a motion to call the question does not require a second, but does require a 2/3 vote of the council.

The motion to call the question passed by the following vote:

For: 6 - Mayor Hallisey, Mr. Becker, Mr. Dugie, Mr. Kinsey, Mr. Gripon and Mr. Long

Opposed: 2 - Mr. Millican and Mr. Gross

Staff advised that a rate of \$.57 is effectively a 3.79% increase in the tax rate. Per the City Attorney, the additional language is technically not needed on the amended motion because as has been pointed out by staff previously in the meeting we are going to have to go through this process again.

The vote to amend the motion failed by the following vote:

For: 4 - Mayor Hallisey, Mr. Millican, Mr. Kinsey and Mr. Gripon

Opposed: 4 - Mr. Becker, Mr. Dugie, Mr. Gross and Mr. Long

The original motion passed by the following vote:

Opposed: 3 - Mayor Hallisey, Mr. Millican and Mr. Gripon
