Jamal,

As per our meeting on 10/12, Kimley Horn has revised the plans and we have sent the revision to our contractor to price. The attached is their proposal. Our intention is to proceed with the first option and we are currently scheduled for this to be on the 11/14/17 City Council Meeting. The City typically awards a project for construction with a small contingency budget, which in this case was approximately \$56,500 to cover item overruns and material testing. The additional cost for this change order is well above our typical project overruns and will require some adjustment of other projects that the City has in planning thru our Capital Improvement Program. Is there anyway that TxDOT would agree to cover a portion of this change order? I realize that this is not typically done, but knowing the difficulty we had on getting these plans approved by District and that the sub-base work was missed by everyone until construction had started I would respectfully request this consideration. A 50/50 split would have the City and TxDOT each responsible for \$61,490.95.

Regardless of your response, I truly appreciate the solid working relationship the City shares with your office (Joyce was a great help to us by keeping this project moving at the District office, your crews aiding in the clean-up in the wake of the flooding, your teams ability to work with us related to the Five Corner Project changes, etc).
