Dear Mayor Hallisey,

The Fairway Pointe Community Association has received concerns from residents regarding the proposed FM518 hike and bike trail, section adjacent to Fairway Pointe and South Shore Golf Course along Genco Canal. In due diligence, we recently conducted a survey of the community and the majority of residents are opposed to the proposed trails. The survey results identified security and safety concern to the resident. Specifically, the danger to individuals using the trail due to the proximity to the golf course and the fact stray golf balls will hit the trail where it runs through Fairway Pointe.

Since the survey, we invited Director, Parks and Cultural Service, Mr Chien Wei, and a League City Police Officer to the Fairway Pointe Community Board Association meeting to discuss the proposed trail project with residents. They provided an update to the design phase and crime statistics of the neighborhood. The residents are still opposed to the proposed trails.

On behalf of the Fairway Pointe Community Association residents, I would like to formally submit opposition to the proposed FM518 hike and bike trail, section adjacent to Fairway Pointe and South Shore Golf Course along Genco Canal due to safety and security concerns. We look forward to working with League City representatives to identify alternative solutions to the proposed trails.
