ORDINANCE CREATING A POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, CONSISTING OF A CHIEF OF POLICE AND SUCH OTHER PERSONNEL AS MAY BE REQUIRED FROM TIME TO TIME, PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF SAID DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY:

Section 1. That there is hereby created a department of police consisting of a Chief of Police and such other officers, patrolmen and employees as the City Council may determine.

Section 2. The director of the police department shall be the Chief of Police. The Chief of Police shall appoint his own assistants subject to the approval of the Council. He shall have immediate direction and control of the police department subject to such rules, regulations and orders as may be prescribed by the Council and shall promulgate all orders, rules and regulations for the government of the police force.

Section 3. The Chief of Police shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the majority of the City Councilmen.

Section 4. The Chief of Police shall be required to give a bond payable to the City for its protection in the amount of \$5,000.00 with a qualified corporate surety and shall qualify by delivering such executed bond and by making oath to perform his duties as required by law.

Section 5. The fact that the City of League City is without adequate police protection creates a public emergency and it is provided that this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage following its first reading, approval thereof.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 17 th day of November, 1963, by the unanimous vote of the City Council.
