Notes:

- (1) The WS&D cost is based on the original contract amount (\$717,100.10) plus change order no. 1 (\$42,300.00) for additional excavatior for future detention storage minus final quantity adjustments of (-\$91,540.00). The District is seeking reimbursement for 28% of all construction costs and 0% of consultant fees. The remaining 72% of construction costs and 100% of consultant fees were requested in bond issue #5
- (2) The WS&D cost is based on the original contract amount (\$851,330.00) minus final quantity adjustments of (-\$65,240). Phase 4 Drainage Improvements included an amenity portion of the lake (\$307,200.00) which was removed as it is not reimbursable in this bond issue and will be reimbursed through a future park bond. The pro rata share for this project is 61% detention and 39% amenity. The District is seeking reimbursement for 100% of all detention construction costs and 100% of consultant fees.
- (3) Tuscan Lakes SF 50-4 was designed as one section, but built into two phases. The total WS&D construction cost for both phases is \$328,629.37 "(Phase 1 by American Site Builders, LLC for a construction costs of \$178,721.37 and Phase 2 by Crostex, LLC for a construction cost of \$149,908.00). The District is seeking all the costs and developers interests for the construction and consultant fees in Phase 1. The construction costs for Phase 2, and resulting developers interest, are requested in Phase 2 in this bond issue.
- (4) Tuscan Lakes SF 50-4 was designed as one section, but built into two phases. The total WS&D construction cost for both phases is \$328,629.37 "(Phase 1 by American Site Builders, LLC for a construction costs of \$178,721.37 and Phase 2 by Crostex, LLC for a construction cost of \$149,908.00). The District is seeking all the costs and developers interests for the construction only and 0% of the fees and developers interest for the consultants for Phase 1. The construction costs for Phase 2 and the remaining 100% of the consultant fees and developers interest are requested in Phase 2 in this bond issue.
- (5) The WS&D cost is based on the original contract amount (\$1,369,921.50) minus final quantity adjustments of (-\$71,589.20). The District is seeking reimbursement for 85% of all construction costs and 85% of consultant fees. The remaining 15% of construction costs and 15% of consultant fees will be requested in a future bond issue.
- (6) The WS&D cost is based on the original contract amount (\$486,284.00) minus final quantity adjustments of (-\$7,585.00). The District is seeking 45% of all construction costs and consultant fees in this bond issue. The remaining 55% of the construction costs and consultant fees were requested in bond issue no. 5.
- (7) The WS&D cost is based on the original contract amount (\$345,653.83) plus change order no. 1 (\$5,960.50) to replace two 5' storm inlets with 10' storm inlets plus change order no. 2 (\$10,902.95) to T.V. sanitary line and strip and regrade rear lot line as per City request plus change order no. 3 (\$3,512.33) to fix rolled gasket in sanitary sewer line minus final quantity adjustments of (-\$40,279.60). The District is seeking reimbursement for 100% of all construction costs and 100% of consultant fees.
- (8) The WS&D cost is based on the original contract amount (\$967,067.40) minus final quantity adjustments of (\$65,620). The District is seeking reimbursement for 15% of all construction costs and 15% of consultant fees. The remaining 85% of construction costs and 85% of consultant fees will be requested in a future bond issue
- (9) Engineering Fees are detailed in Attachment 8.
- (10) Geotech fees were paid to Terracon for their services.
- (11) Surveying fees were paid to GeoSurv for their services.
- (12) Fees for stormwater consultation and stormwater pollution prevention were paid to Stormwater Solutions and CleanSite for their services

- (14) The Capital Recovery Fee is based on 171 total connections. There are 35 water connections and 35 sanitary sewer connections with a combined rate of \$4,023.25 per single-family equivalent connection, based on a rate of \$1401.77 for water and \$2,621.48 for sanitary sewer.
