**Proposition A – Issuance of \$73,000,000 of General Obligation Bonds for Flood Protection and Drainage Improvements, and the levying of the tax in payment thereof** 

2,447 For 67.73% 1,166 Against 32.27%

Proposition B – Issuance of \$72,000,000 of General Obligation Bonds for Streets, Roadways and Mobility Improvements, and the levying of the tax in payment thereof

> 2,321 For 64.36% 1,285 Against 35.64%

Proposition C – Adoption of a Local Sales and Use Tax in the City of League City at the Rate of One and One Quarter Percent (1.25%)

2,225 For 61.74% 1,379 Against 38.26%
