Enclosed for your review and approval is the award recommendation for Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 19-CIP-016 Fire Training Room Expansion. There were three packages received pursuant to solicitation 19-CIP-016 Fire Training Room Expansion. They were all thoroughly reviewed by Joiner Architects.

HISTORY

On May 20, 2019 ITB 19-CIP-016 Fire Training Room Expansion was released to the public. The objective of the solicitation was to seek one vendor to add a 945 square foot addition to an existing pre-engineered metal building, which includes a new concrete foundation, pre-engineered metal building, interior finish-out, mechanical systems, electrical, lighting and incidentals required for the project. The following language was inserted: "The City of League City reserves the right to accept or reject all or any part of any solicitation, waive, minor technicalities and award the bid to best serve the interest of the City of League City". Bids were received and opened June 4, 2019 at 2:00 pm CST.
