

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-05

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF § 545.356, TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE, UPON THE BASIS OF AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION, UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS, OF PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE, AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, § 545.356, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, provides that whenever the governing body of the city shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of a street or highway within the city, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street or highway;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LEAGUE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and opinions in the preamble of this ordinance are true and correct and are incorporated into this ordinance.

Section 2. Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation heretofore made as authorized by the provisions of § 545.356, Texas Transportation Code, the following prima facie speed limits hereafter indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe; and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the named streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

Along SH 96 from intersection IH-45 to the intersection of Tuscan Lakes Village, a distance of approximately 2.297 miles, the speed limit shall be 45 MPH.

Along SH 96 from intersection of Tuscan Lakes Village to the centerline of Columbia Memorial Parkway, a distance of approximately 2.480 miles, the speed limit shall be 50 MPH.

Along SH 96 from the centerline of Columbia Memorial Parkway to the eastern city limit of League City, a distance of approximately 1.183 miles, the speed limit shall be 55 MPH.

Along SH 96 a school zone from 1056 ft. west of Lawrence Road to 1215 feet east of Lawrence Road, a distance of approximately 0.430 miles, the speed limit shall be 35 MPH WHEN FLASHING.

Section 3. Should any section or part of this ordinance be held unconstitutional illegal, or invalid, or the application to any person or circumstance for any reasons thereof ineffective or inapplicable, such unconstitutionality, illegality, invalidity, ineffectiveness of such section or part shall in no way affect, impair or invalidate the remaining portion or portions thereof; but

as to such remaining portion or portions, the same shall be and remain in full force and effect and to end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 4. All ordinances and agreements and parts of ordinances and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.


Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street or highway.

Section 6. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.




