Arson/Command Trailer Timeline

February 27, 2018 – Council approved the submission of a grant application to the Office of the Governor – <u>FY18 Homeland Security Grant Division (\$195,000)</u> and the submission of a separate application to the <u>FY18 Office of the Governor – Criminal Justice Division (\$195,000)</u> for an Arson/Command Trailer. To simplify the agenda package, both grant requests were placed into Agenda #18-0094 by city staff. The agenda item and Resolution #2018-26 was approved unanimously by (6) attending Council Members and Mayor. Two (2) were absent – Gross and Long.

May 14, 2018 – The <u>Criminal Justice Division Grant</u> notified the League City Fire Marshal's Office that our \$195,000.00 grant request was denied, and no funding was granted.

October 24, 2018 – The <u>Homeland Security Grant Division</u> notified the League City Fire Marshal's Office that our requested grant of \$195,000.00 was partially funded for a total amount of \$79,281.13.

November 26, 2018 – The City went out for bids (RFP #19-FireMar-004) on the Arson/Command Trailer. Two bids were received back but were disqualified by the committee due to pricing and the failure to meet the general specifications and guidelines.

January 22, 2019 - Council approved to reject all original bids due to unqualified bidders and approved to proceed with a new bidding process. The agenda item 9C (#19-0035) and Resolution #2019-10 was approved unanimously by Council Members and Mayor.

January 28, 2019 – Posted bids for the second time (RFP #19-FireMar-004A) and received one bid. The total bid price received was \$214,198.27. The committee reviewed the one bid and after negotiations purchased the trailer without equipment in order to stay within the grant funding amount of \$79,281.13.

February 26, 2019 – Council approved entering into a contract with Rolltechs Specialty Vehicles, LLC for \$79,254.74 for a base trailer without equipment. Agenda Item 9B #19-0124 and Resolution # 2019-36. The agenda item was approved (6) For (1) Opposed, (1) Absent.

February 26, 2019 – Council approved the submission of a grant to the Office of the Governor – Public Safety Office – FY19 State Homeland Security Grant Program for \$131,230 for equipment and electronics for the Command Trailer. Item 9C #19-0125 and Resolution #2019-37 was approved 6 For, 1 Opposed, 1 Absent.

October 10, 2019 – League City Fire Marshal's Office received notice of funding in the amount of \$109,000 from the FY19 State Homeland Security Grant application.

November 19, 2019 – Asking council to approve entering into a contract not to exceed \$76,750.57 with Rolltechs Specialty Vehicles, LLC for equipment and electronics. The remaining balance (\$32,070.85) will be used to purchase (5) APX8500 mobile radios to be installed in the trailer by Rolltechs Specialty Vehicles, LLC.
