A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION THAT WILL BE USED TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 2020 F-150 POLICE RESPONDER VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT EOD BOMB TECHNICIANS FOR THE FY2020 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM (LETPA PROJECTS) AND THE NAMING OF THE GRANT MANAGERS
