Re: Request for Emergency Interconnect with Galveston County WCID 12

Dear Mr. Baumgartner:

Galveston County Water Control and Improvement District No. 12 (District) is requesting an emergency interconnect with the City of League City. This emergency interconnect will be located in the southwest quadrant of the intersection of FM 518 and Lawrence Road within an existing 25-foot water easement along FM 518. The quantity of water being requested for a single day emergency is 1,000,000 gallons. This one day emergency water request would be for a worst case scenario during summer months and maximum water usage of the District. The plans for this interconnect have already been through the City of League City's review process. We are currently addressing comments on the plans and should have them resubmitted to the City in the next week or two. Our plans are proposing a 10-inch Sensus Omni F2 meter with remote read technology installed with vault. The meter will be located between isolation valves so the meter can be removed as needed. The District will be responsible for the design and construction/installation of the emergency interconnect with League City

If you have any questions or comments about the information above please do not hesitate to contact me a 713.450.1300. It is my understanding with the information provided above the City can prepare a draft inter-local agreement between the District and League City for the emergency interconnect.
