

This grant will pay for 90% of the actual cost of bunker gear. Not to exceed \$15,000 in grant assistance. In 2014 we submitted an application to the Texas Forest Service for reimbursement of bunker gear purchased that year. That application is still on file with the Texas Forest Service. We are only allowed to have one application on file at a time for bunker gear/PPE reimbursement. This application from 2014 will remain on file with TFS until we are awarded the funds or if we decide to pull the application. If we pull the application, we lose our spot in line and go to the bottom of the funding list.
