Purchase any combination of compensation insurance for firefighters from a Texas insurance company. You **must** have an active policy to apply for this grant.

Complete and submit the following:

- Rural VFD Insurance Program Application for Assistance for Calendar Year 2021
- Roster of Active fire department members
- W-9
- Copy of the paid insurance policy
 - Workers' Compensation
 - Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance
 - Group Term Life Insurance
 - Accident and Sickness Insurance
 - Cancer-related Insurance

Submit via fax, email, or mail.

Important:

- The policy or payment documents must show the policy number, the cost or premium amount, and the coverage period.
- All required reimbursement documents must accompany the grant application form.
- Only ONE application per department will be reimbursed for the enrollment period of November 2020 through July 31, 2021.
- The program will reimburse 100% of the actual cost of eligible insurance coverage up to a maximum of **\$175** per fire department member.
