1. <u>CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS</u>

Rebecca Underhill, Assistant City Manager said I appreciate you taking the time to come to this special meeting to get this important work done. This report satisfies the requirements of Section 26.04 of the Property Tax Code, which requires that the governing body receive this information from the tax assessor. As you know the Galveston County Tax Assessor-Collector serves as the city's Tax Assessor-Collector by contract. Her office works with our Finance Department personnel to prepare these calculations. So beginning with the Certified Taxable Value for 2016, this is the period that will fund FY2017 budget, total taxable value is \$7,155,494,844. Of that \$6,890,096,439 is certified and \$265,398,405 is under ARB review with the appraisal districts. That is an increase of \$702,233,562 from last year, 10.9%. Included in those amounts are \$264,694,333 in new property added to the rolls, 14.7% increase from last year. Those numbers are critical in the calculation of the Effective tax rate and the Rollback rate. The Effective tax rate was calculated at \$0.550866. This is the rate that would generate the same property tax revenue on properties that were taxed in both years. The Rollback rate was calculated at \$0.579816, the highest rate that can be set before taxpayers have the right to begin rollback procedures (petition for an election) to reject the rate and "roll back" the rate to this maximum. There is no action required on this agenda item.
