Also presented were the FY2019 General Fund Summary, FY2018 Items Effect on General Fund Summary, FY2019 Proposed Budget Utility Fund Summary. FY2018 year-end projected system revenue is \$619,700 less than the FY2017 Actual. FY2019 Proposed Budget revenue is increased based on growth percentages projected in the Long Range Financial Forecast and is \$880,750 more than the FY2018 year-end estimate. FY2018 Utility Fund is expected to end the year with a \$11.22 million fund balance, \$3.90 million of which fulfills the financial policy requirement of 90 days of operating expenses.
