2. PRESENTATION REGARDING PROPOSED MEDIAN AND LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG TXDOT RIGHTS OF WAY IN LEAGUE CITY

David Hoover, Executive Director of Development Services gave a presentation.

Staff has been working with TxDOT on several possible projects in the City for FY2021 that include median and landscape improvements on many of the TxDOT roads.

- Some of the projects will be paid by TxDOT out of construction funds and some will be paid through the TxDOT Green Ribbon program.
- Entryway signage would be paid for from a Keep Texas Beautiful Governor's Community Achievement Award

All are funded 100% with no match needed

• Only design and specifications will be required.

Projects would be bid, awarded, and managed by TxDOT and include a two-year maintenance and guarantee

• After two years, the City would be responsible for maintenance.
