The proposed ordinance changes include updating, adding, and removing regulations within the Zoning Ordinance. The proposed changes consist of the following:

- 1. Create regulations related to stacking and queuing, and revise regulations related to drive-through facilities.
- 2. Create a definition for industrialized housing.
