Presentation of a proclamation declaring May 1 - 7, 2016 as American Water Works Association “National Drinking Water Week” (Council Member Bentley & Mayor Hallisey)

For more than 35 years, the American Water Works Association and its members have celebrated National Drinking Water Week. This is a unique opportunity for both water professionals and the communities they serve to join together to recognize the vital role water plays in our daily lives. The City of League City formally recognizes this week and coordinates water conservation and reuse public outreach events to coincide. This year, National Drinking Water Week is celebrated from May 1-7, 2016. This year’s theme is “Your Water, to know it is to love it”. Activities associated with Drinking Water Week include the annual poster contest, annual essay contest, toddler story time at the Helen Hall Library, rain barrel distribution, Captain H2O/Water Production Staff lunchtime visit to local elementary and informational water conservation events at the three Kroger locations in League City.
