

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TWO-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH ARTHUR J. GALLAGHER & CO. FOR RISK ADVISORY AND INSURANCE BROKERAGE SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$98,455

WHEREAS, the City of League City, Texas (the "City"), issued Request for Proposals No. 26-019 seeking qualified firms to provide risk advisory and insurance brokerage services; and

WHEREAS, proposals were evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP, including experience with public entities, qualifications, service approach, and cost; and

WHEREAS, Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. was selected as the highest-ranked proposer and determined to be the firm best qualified to provide the requested services in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. demonstrated substantial experience providing risk management and insurance brokerage services to public sector clients and proposed a comprehensive scope of services aligned with the City's risk management needs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes a two-year professional services agreement with Arthur J. Gallagher & Co for risk advisory and insurance brokerage services in an amount not to exceed \$98,455; and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
